

NUNAVIK PARKS BENEFICIARY ACCESS INITIATIVE (NPBAI)

Air transportation financial assistance form to be completed before your trip to a Nunavik national park.

The Nunavik Parks Beneficiary Access Initiative (NPBAI) aims to facilitate and encourage access to Nunavik's various national parks for beneficiaries of the James Bay and Northern Québec Agreement (JBNQA).

This program pays a portion of the airfare for scheduled and charter flights used specifically to visit a Nunavik national park.*



* This initiative is in addition to the free access and accommodation (cabins, camping) in Nunavik's parks for beneficiaries, as provided for in the Parks Act.

SUBMITTING AN APPLICATION

Beneficiaries (individuals or groups) wishing to take advantage of the funds available under this initiative must complete this pre-approval form before travelling to a park. The application will be processed within 10 working days of receipt to confirm admissibility.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF THE INITIATIVE

- For scheduled or charter flights, a 75% price reduction of the amount shown on the airline invoice will be provided for the ticket. For groups, the price reduction applies only to beneficiaries and will be calculated on a pro rata basis. Invoices must be submitted no later than one month after the trip to the park.
- A cheque will be issued after verification with park management confirming that you have visited the park.
- The financial aid granted under this initiative may not be combined with other public funding covering the same expenses.
- The flight must originate from a Nunavik community (including Whapmagoostui and Kawawachikamach). The destination must be one of the national parks in Nunavik. The flight must involve the most direct connections possible.
- The NPBAI applies to a maximum of two visits to a Nunavik park per person per year (between January 1 and December 31).
- Applications will be approved subject to the availability of funds for this initiative.

This program may be modified or cancelled at any time.
